



FITTING FORM ANALYSIS

Dear Jason,

You can take this fitting to any club builder with a guarantee from Arizona Custom Golf Clubs that 'The fitting is 90% correct,' your body and mind will adapt the other 10% over time. Here are the fitting recommendation based on, 1) the results of your club fitting analysis and, 2) comments made regarding your ball flight tendencies. My recommendations are:

Length: +1inch over men's standard due to your 38 & ½ wrist to ground measurement

Driver length=45 inches (graphite)

Iron length=38 & ½ -- 5-iron

Grip size: + 3wraps or .945 over men's standard-Star Wrap

Shaft flex: Stiff flex based on club speed of 95 MPH (driver)

Shaft Material: Woods --60-65 gram, R&S-Graphite (stiff)--

Irons-- 125 gram R& S, steel Parallel, 370 tip.

Lie: 4-degrees upright—2 thru bending + 2 effective lie= 4 up

Club selection: irons-3,4,5,6,7,8,9,pw & SW and Lob

Woods-460 CC 10.5 degrees of loft

Fairway woods—5-wood (Std-loft) & 19 degree Hybrid

(3-metal optional for tight driving holes)

Swing Weight: D-4 (5) due to length.

Putter length: 35 & 1/2 inches

Pureing: Each shaft is pured at NO Charge

Comments: Jason, you should also think about taking a few golf lessons because your divot pattern is "out-side-to-in" this means you are cutting across the ball and you tend to slice from left to right. Let me know if I can build you a great set of CUSTOM CLUBS based on this analysis. I would also like to see your swing the next time you come to Phoenix.
